Three out of every five young people living in areas of high deprivation stay there for life. That's simply not good enough. WHAT WE HAVE ACHIEVED SO FAR

- 3,000 tamariki students and families attending Symphony in the Hutt.
- 700+ Magic Cards for kids up to year 9. Each magic card giving free entry to Hutt City Council pools, free internet, issues and printing at HCC libraries.
- Each week, free buses have taken schools on educational trips to Te Papa, Parliament, Westpac Stadium, and more.
- 5000+ tickets to Hurricanes, Wellington Lions, Phoenix games for students and their families.
- RIDE Holidays have donated 320 bikes and helmets to low decile schools.
- Corporate partners have donated laptops, computers, professional advice, and Christmas presents to local schools.



Our aim for 2021 is to continue to provide free busses for low decile schools, facilitating over 2,500 experiences. Planning is underway for a third free Symphony in the Hutt concert in May. The WIFI project is currently in front of Government Departments and the MP's to provide free WIFI access and opportunities to all low decile schools in the Hutt Valley.

A key source of TAKA Trust's funding that enables these successes is the annual charity golf tournament.
